## History

Reclaiming has had 5 large Dandelion Gatherings in 5 different communities around the country every 2 years since 2004. These are gatherings of the Reclaiming families and tribes from across the country and around the world. At the Dandelion Gathering last year, there was a consensus decision to move the larger Dandelion Gatherings to every 4 years and to do some Regional Dandelions in the interim. **Tejas Regional Dandelion** will be a magical extended-weekend gathering open to all ages and inclusive of our significant others and families. Tejas Web has previously created several Wildflower Gatherings that were similar and also hosted the first big Dandelion Gathering in 2004.

## ACTIVITIES

The structure of Dandelion Gathering is flexible and easily holds a variety of activities, magic, and fun. We welcome all who are called by the intention, including children and partners. Join us for **Samhain Magic, Family and Community, Reclaiming-style Ritual, Drumming and Dancing with Ancestors and Fae, Hikes in the Wild, Pumpkin Carving, Children's Activities, Costume Party, and vital Political Magic on the eve of the 2014 election.**

**The fee covers 4 days of food, accommodation and activities.** Comfy indoor beds, tenting discounts, plenty of bathrooms, hot tub, AND delicious, organic, locally-grown food.

Dandelion runs Thursday afternoon through Sunday morning. Arrive when you can, stay as long as you wish, come and go if you need to.

This is a drug-free and alcohol-free gathering.

## ACCOMMODATIONS

There are plenty of lovely tenting spaces at Dandelion! Indoor bathrooms and showers are available for tenters (no port-a-potties). Indoor dorm rooms sleep four people. (Semi-private rooms are now sold out: to get on the wait list in case a semi-private space opens up, contact Amanda at [flyingfishdesigns@sbcglobal.net](mailto:flyingfishdesigns@sbcglobal.net).)

**FEES August 2 through October 29 (as space is available):  
\$190 for tenting, \$250 for dorm bed accommodation.**

These fees apply to adults and to teenagers 13-17. Children 12 and under may tent free of charge; they may sleep inside free of charge if they sleep in a bed with an adult, or bring a camp bed or mattress and sleep in the same room with the accompanying adult.

Please get in touch with us if you need **financial assistance** to join us at Dandelion 2014. Assistance is available in the form of work exchanges, partial scholarships, or support for families for whom the above fee structure is not workable.

## PAYMENTS

Through September 15, a **deposit** of HALF the appropriate fee reserves your place at the rate that applied when you paid the deposit.

**If you pay a deposit, the balance of your registration fee is DUE SEPTEMBER 15.**

**If you register between September 16 and October 29 you must pay in full at the time of registration.**

**Refund policy:** The deposit is non-refundable. If you pay in full but then withdraw by October 1, we will refund the balance you paid, less the deposit. If you pay in full but withdraw October 2 or afterwards, or don't show up, no refund will be granted.
